

The City of Woodburn is currently seeking applicants for the position of Full-time, Part-Time, and Reserve Officer.

An applicant must:

- Be 21 years old at the time of hire;
- Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate;
- Be a US Citizen;
- Possess a valid driver's license;
- Good moral character and have no felony convictions or misdemeanor domestic violence convictions;
- Pass a mandatory drug screening;
- Pass a voice stress analysis test, or equivalency;
- Pass a standard physical and mental examination;
- Be willing to reside within 5 miles of the City of Woodburn;
- Be Honorably Discharged if prior military;
- Successfully complete pre-employment physical fitness test.

**Base pay for the City of Woodburn's Full-Time Officer position for calendar year 2019 is between \$39,500-\$48,000 annually based on experience as determined by the Board of Works.**

**Base pay for the City of Woodburn's Part-Time Officer position for calendar year 2019 is between \$15-\$20 per hour based on experience as determined by the Board of Works.**

**Reserve Officers are not paid positions within the City of Woodburn.**
