Join the celebration as Woodburn Main Street organization is hosting “A Party on the Plaza” to celebrate Downtown Development Week.

Folkcraft Dulcimer Players will perform starting at 1:15. Come enjoy a free concert and the various planned activities.

Along with the music there will be a pumpkin decorating contest for ages Kindergarten – 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 7<sup>th</sup> grade through high school. Pumpkins must be brought by the student to compete.. Judging will be at 1:30 with prizes of \$25.00 for 1<sup>st</sup> place and \$10.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup> in each age group.

Face painting will be done throughout the day for kids and “kids at heart”.

Another event will be a pie baking contest with two categories: one for homemade pumpkin pies and one for homemade apple pies. First place in each category will receive \$10.00. Pies will be cut and offered to the public.

The second event is a pumpkin decorating contest by our local businesses. Each business has been given a pumpkin to decorate, and the community is encouraged to visit the businesses and cast their vote for their favorite. Winners will be determined by the pumpkin receiving the most votes. Contest runs from Monday, Oct 8 – Friday noon, Oct 11. Votes will be counted at each business, and 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive \$50.00 and 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$25.00.

October 7 - 12 is being designated as Downtown Development week by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs. (OCRA). Rural cities and communities across Indiana will be on display and celebrated during this week.

In 2013, Woodburn became an Indiana Main Street community under OCRA's administration. Much of the funding for Woodburn's improved Streetscape came through an OCRA grant. The second phase of our Streetscape project is scheduled to commence in early 2020 through the New Allen Alliance's Stellar Designation, also with OCRA funding.

To join OCRA's celebration, Woodburn's Main Street group is planning two different events. The first is "**FREAKY PUMPKIN FRENZY**", a pumpkin decorating contest by the local businesses.. Main Street members will distribute the pumpkins. Participating business will be publicized, and the community will be encouraged to visit the businesses and cast their vote for their favorite pumpkin. Contest ends at noon on Friday when Main Street members will count the votes at each business site. Pictures will be posted on our Facebook page and the City's web page. Prizes are \$50.00 for 1<sup>st</sup> place and \$25.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Winners will be announced at the "**PARTY ON THE PLAZA**" by the Clock tower.

**"PARTY ON THE PLAZA"** will be on Saturday, October 12 from 1:00 pm-4:00 pm. Kids must bring their decorated pumpkins to the Clock Tower. Judging will be at 2:00 with two categories, one for ages Kindergarten through 6<sup>th</sup> grade and the other 7<sup>th</sup> grade through high school. Prizes of \$25.00 for 1<sup>st</sup> and \$10.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup> will be given in each age group. Judging will be by Mayor and City Council members.

Another contest will be a pie baking contest with two categories: one for homemade pumpkin pies and one for homemade apple pies. First place in each category will receive \$10.00. Pies will be cut and offered to the public.

Other activities will include entertainment by Folkcraft Dulcimer players, and local youth groups, free face painting, and free hot dogs, chips, and a drink.
