

ORDINANCE NO – 21-1396

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FIRE PROTECTION TERRITORY
EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND**

Under Indiana Code 36-8-19-8.5

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of Woodburn, Allen County, Indiana, that a need now exists for the establishment of a Fire Protection Territory Equipment Replacement Fund for the Woodburn – New Haven Fire & EMS Protection Territory for all uses as set out in Indiana Code 36-8-19-8.5.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Common Council will adhere to the provisions of Indiana Code 36-8-19-8.5. The proposed fund will not exceed \$0.0333 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. Said tax rate will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in 2022 and thereafter, continuing until reduced or rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that proofs of publication of the public hearing held on the 1st day of March 2021, and a certified copy of this ordinance shall be submitted to the Department of Local Government Finance of the State of Indiana as provided by law. This Fire Protection Territory Equipment Replacement Fund is subject to the approval of the Department of Local Government Finance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of New Haven is the Provider Unit of the Woodburn – New Haven Fire & EMS Protection Territory. The other participating units are the City of Woodburn, City of New Haven, Adams Township, Jefferson Township, Milan Township and Maumee Township, all in Allen County. New Haven, as Provider Unit, is authorized to establish this Fund.

This ordinance contains or incorporates by reference the contents of the agreement to establish the Fund.

Duly adopted by the following vote of the members of said Common Council of the City of Woodburn, Allen County, Indiana, this 1st day of March, 2021.
