The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has mandated that all Water providers test homes for lead and copper in the water. While these contaminants are not in the source water, lead and copper contaminants can enter through corrosion of older household plumbing materials. In order for the water system to be able to comply with the EPA's new requirements, it is also required under the drinking Water Act to send surveys to all customers asking that they complete and return the survey form. Customer participation is appreciated to help the water system comply with these government regulations by monitoring the water quality.
