

ORDINANCE NO. 25-1431
CONCERNING THE FLOOD HAZARDS WITHIN
THE CITY OF WOODBURN

WHEREAS, Allen County Ordinance No. 05-02-25-05 (Allen County Code Title 21) has been adopted concerning building and improvements in flood hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, jurisdictions desiring to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program are required to be covered by an ordinance such as Allen County Ordinance No. 05-02-25-05 (Allen County Code Title 21) and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that real estate located within the jurisdiction of the City of Woodburn be eligible for insurance available pursuant to the National Flood Insurance Program.

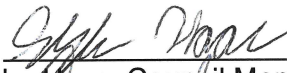
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the City of Woodburn does hereby indicate its intention to maintain participation in the National Flood Insurance Program.

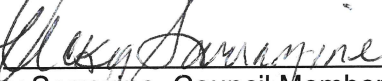

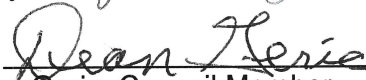
